What Degree Course are you studying?

BSc Quantity Surveying at Liverpool John Moores University.

What did your role involve?

As a Project Assistant at MDA, you are valued as a full member of the Contract Administration team working with Senior Project Managers. I was surprised how much responsibility I was given during my placement year, at points I felt slightly out of my comfort zone, but MDA always ensured that I had the correct training and knowledge to satisfy clients. What skills, training and knowledge did you experience?
